Bronze Speaking Summary of Procedures

The usher introduces the child to the examiner.

- 1. After asking the child "What's your name?", the examiner familiarizes the child with the picture first and then asks the child to point out certain items on the scene picture, e.g. "Where's the door?" The examiner then asks the child to put two object cards in various locations on the scene picture, e.g. "Put the robot on the red chair."
- 2. The examiner asks questions about two of the people or things in the scene picture, e.g. "What's this?" (Answer: banana) "What color is it?" (Answer: yellow). The examiner also asks the child to describe an object from the scene, e.g. "Tell me about this box."
- 3. The examiner asks questions about four object cards, e.g. "What's this?" (Answer: (orange) juice) and "What do you drink for lunch?"
- 4. The examiner asks questions about the child, e.g. "Which sport do you like?"
